Shah Gul's Success Story:

The success story of Shah Gul, a woman in Takhar province.

Shah Gul, a resident of Qura Bai village in Taluqan city, the center of the northeastern province of Takhar, is 50-year-old and has 10 children.

She had no income source before joining the 500 Broiler Poultry Production Model Project funded by NHLP/MAIL as a beneficiary. The project is implemented by Afghanistan Social Improvement Organization (ASIO) in Takhar province.



According to MAIL, Shah Gul has now increased her income multiple times more than her husband.

She was very much interested in poultry farming. She was selected as a beneficiary for the poultry project at the beginning of 2019 through which she received required training on new techniques and methods of poultry farming.

She also received 500 pullets and a farm along with its required accessories, feed, and medicine through the project.

She kept the pullets for 35 days and succeeded to sell them. In two rounds, she raised 1,000 pullets and sold them for Afs250 each after 35 days.

Shah Gul earned Afs97,500 as a net benefit and bought a cow for Afs40,000 using the money she earned from poultry farming.

Now, she affords the daily needs of her family as well as the needs of her children's education. She eyes improving her business.
